**RECRUITMENT FOR THE POSTS OF
CONSTABLE (TRADESMEN) CADRE - 2010**

Applications are invited from eligible male Indian citizens for filling up the following Group 'C' Combatised, Non-Gazetted (Non-Ministerial) posts in tradesmen cadres in SSB for the year 2010 in the pay scale of Rs.5200-20200 + Grade Pay Rs.2000 Per month plus usual and admissible allowances to Central Government employees including ration allowance, medical assistance, free uniform, free accommodation, free leave passes etc. The post is temporary but likely to become permanent. The posts have all India transfer liability and selected candidates can be posted anywhere in India and abroad. On appointment, the candidate shall be governed by SSB Act and Rules. Last date of receipt of application is 10.12.2010 for all states except for Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep for which the last date is 17.12.2010.

2. Only Male candidates need to apply for the posts advertised.

2. Pay Scale and Other Allowances :

Pay Scale : (Pay Band – 1) : Rs.5200-20200 + Grade Pay Rs.2000/- per month.

3. Other Allowances:

The post will carry Dearness Allowance, Ration Money, Washing Allowance, Free Uniform, Free accommodation or HRA, Transport Allowance, Free Leave Pass and any other allowance as admissible in the Force from time to time under the Rules/ Instructions.

They will be covered under new restructured contributory pension scheme.

A candidate appearing in the recruitment test must mention / intimate if any criminal cases (s) is / are pending / contemplated against him in any Police station / Hon'ble Court.

4. Eligibility Conditions :**A) Age**

- (i) 18 to 23 years (Cut-off date for age will be 10-12-2010)
- (ii) The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from the candidates i.e 10.12.2010 (and not the closing date prescribed for candidates of Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep).

Note

- (a) Upper age limit is relaxable for SC/ST by 5 years, and 3 years for OBC candidate.
- (b) 5(five) years of age relaxation will be admissible to the candidates who had ordinarily been domiciled in the state of J&K during the period from 01.01.1980 to 31.12.1989.
- (c) Five years of age relaxation will also be granted to the children and dependent family members of those killed in the riots (1984 riots and 2002 communal riots of

Gujarat).SC / ST/ OBC relaxation, as per Govt. instructions, which will be in addition to this relaxation. **Children means** (a) son (including adopted son); or **Dependent family members mean:** (a) spouse: or (b) children: or(c) brother in case of unmarried Govt. servant who was wholly dependent on the Govt. Servant at the time of his killing in the riots. Children and dependent family members of those killed in the riots (1984 riots and 2002 communal riots of Gujarat) will produce a certificate from the concerned District Collector.

(d) One time age relaxation of 3 years in upper age limit will be given to the trained ITVs of SSB for recruitment in SSB as Constables as a special case, subject to fulfillment of other prescribed eligibility condition. This relaxation in upper age limit will be in addition to the existing relaxation in age limit for SC/ST/OBC category candidates, Candidates must produce supporting documents in support of their claim.

(e) Ex-servicemen who has put in not less than six months continuous service in the Armed Forces shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from his actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the prescribed maximum age by more than three years, he shall be deemed to satisfy the condition regarding age limit. **The eligibility conditions for Ex-servicemen are as under:-**

- I. Physical standard: Total relaxation
- II. Medical category: Category-A(SHAPE-I)
- III. Character: Exemplary/Very Good/Good
- IV. Break in service: Not more than 24 months
- V. Education:-Total relaxation in civil education but Army Education Should be equivalent to Matric.

(B) Educational & Other Qualifications for all posts:

1) Matriculation or equivalent form a recognized Board or Institute.

(8th Class pass for the ST Candidates of Mizoram State, Tirap and Changlang districts of Arunachal Pradesh only)

and

- 2) (i) Two years work experience in respective trade; **OR**
(ii) One year certificate course from Industrial Training Institute/ Vocational Institute with at least one year experience in the Trade ; **OR**
(iii) Two years Diploma from Industrial Training Institute in the trade or similar trade.
- 3) Must qualify trade test .

Note: For the post of Ct. (Cook) /Washerman /Barber/ Safaiwala, Water Carrier/ waiter /Tailor/ Gardner/ Cobbler, Multi-skilled candidates will be given preference.

6. Medical Standards:

- (a) **Vision:** Minimum distant vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 of both eyes without correction, i.e. without wearing glasses.
- (b) The candidates must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes and they should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily health

and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of duties. They should conform to the medical standards prescribed by the Force and should be declared fit by a board of Medical Officers of SSB.

7. How to apply:

A. Documents required for submitting Application:

- a) Application form on the prescribed format duly filled in Hindi or English.
- b) Attested copy of Date of Birth Certificate as per Matriculation Certificate.
- c) Attested copy of educational qualification certificate from recognised school / institution
- d) Attested copy of relevant category (SC / ST / OBC) and domicile certificate as per given format.
- e) Domicile certificate issued by the revenue authority not below the rank of Tehsildar. West Pakistani Refugee settle in J&K are exempted to produce domicile certificate, they will produce certificate issued by the village Sarapanch/ Numbardar alongwith a copy of the electoral roll showing the name of the candidate in the voter list for election of the Parliamentary Constituency
- f) Three latest passport size photographs duly attested (one photo should be pasted on the application form, one on admit card and the last one should be attached with the application form).
- g) IPO / Bank Draft for Rs. 50/- (for General and OBC Candidates only) Non refundable.
- h) Two self addressed envelopes of 4”X9” size with Rs.6/- postage stamps duly affixed on each envelope.
- i) Envelope containing Application must be super-scribed in bold letters **“Application for the Post of “Constable (mention name of trade) and Post Code ()**.
- j) Attested copy of technical qualification certificate issued by the recognised institute or ITI relating to post.
- k) Attested copy of related certificate of experience issued by employer / institute / body recognised by Govt. of India / State Govt.
- l) Attested copy of OBCs as mentioned in the list by Govt. of India are only eligible for reservation as OBC candidates. Caste Certificate of SC / ST / OBC issued by the Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar or equal competent authorities as designated by the concerned states is valid. **SC/ST/OBC Candidates must submit caste certificate on prescribed format as per Annexure – IV (for SC / ST) and III for OBC.**
- (m) Attested copy of Discharge certificate in case of Ex-Servicemen.
- (n) Attested copies of certificate issued by District Collector for children / dependents of victim killed in 1984 riots and riots of 2002 in Gujarat.
- (o) Attested copies of certificate in support of their claim for ITVs of SSB.

(p) Experience Certificate of relevant trade.

Eligible candidates should send their Applications (duly filled in Hindi or English only) complete in all respect and Candidate's Admit Card duly filled in, in the prescribed proforma as per **Annexure 'I' and Annexure 'II'**, either type written or neatly hand written on one side only on full size plain paper with passport size photographs affixed on application and on admit card (duly attested by Gazetted Officer) along with **application fee and the enclosures** to the authority mentioned above. The last date for receipt of application for all States is **10.12.2010** except for Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiti district and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District or Himachal Pradesh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep, for which the last date is **17.12.2010**.

8. Application Fee:

Application Fee will be Rs.50/- (Non-refundable) for candidates belonging to General and OBC category only and no fee will be charged from SC / ST and Ex-Servicemen candidates. The Candidates should attach the **Indian Postal Order or Crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of "The Accounts Officer, SHQ, SSB, Gorakhpur (UP)"**

9. Selection Process :

The eligible candidates shall be issued Admit Cards to appear in recruitment tests. The date and place of recruitment test will be indicated in the Admit Card. The Candidates will have to undergo the following documentation test and other tests:-

(i) Documentation

The candidates who report at the designated recruitment centre on the given date and time will be first summoned to submit their call letter and other documents in original for verification of age and educational qualifications etc. Original documents will be returned on the spot after verification and photocopies will be retained with the application form. Candidates should bring attested photocopies of documents as mentioned above.

(ii) Physical Measurement (PST) :

Candidates who are found eligible on screening of applications will be screened first medically as per para (5) under heading 'Physical Standard' mentioned above.

(iii) **Physical Efficiency Test (PET)** :The candidates who are found fit in above Physical Measurements, will be required to pass Physical Efficiency Test consisting of following events which is qualifying in nature:-

- (a) One Mile (i.e. 1600 meters) race to be completed in ten minutes.
- (b) 11 feet long jump (maximum three chances).
- (c) 3.5 feet high Jump (maximum three chances).

Note: 1. Those who do not qualify the above Physical Efficiency Tests will get eliminated from the process and will not be allowed to appear in any further test.
2. No physical efficiency test will be held for Ex-Servicemen. However, Ex-Servicemen will be required to pass the requisite written examination, trade test and medical examination.

(iv) **Written test (25 Marks)** : The candidates who qualify in the Physical Efficiency Test will be required to appear in a written test which will consist of questions of General Awareness/ General Knowledge, Knowledge of Elementary Mathematics, ability to observe and distinguish patterns and to test basic knowledge of candidate in English / Hindi. The questions will be objective type with multiple options and can be answered either in Hindi or English. The candidate must qualify the Written Test.

Qualifying Marks for written	33% for SC / ST / OBC
	35% for General & Ex-servicemen

(v) **Practical /Trade Test(75 Marks)** :Candidates who qualify the Written Test will be put through Trade Test as per requirement of the job concerned. Candidates will have to pass the Trade Test. The Board of Officers will decide the events of the test in accordance with guidelines issued by FHQ.

Qualifying Marks for Trade test	50% for all categories
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Note:- The candidate shall bring their own tools required for his Trade Test.

(vi) **Medical Test**: Short listed candidates will be medically examined after the trade test to assess their physical and medical fitness as prescribed in the eligibility conditions. Those who fail in the Medical examination will not be considered for the post.

10. **Appeal against the findings of Medical Examination**

If a candidate is declared unfit in the detailed medical examination, the grounds for rejection will be communicated to him by the Chairman. The rejected candidates will obtain Form 4, 5 & 6 from the Chairman concerned, if not satisfied with the findings of the Medical Officer, to prefer an appeal for Review-medical examination to **Inspector General (Pers.), SSB Force HQ, R.K. Puram, New Delhi**, within 15 days from the date of issue of communication in which the findings of the Medical Officer is communicated to the candidate. The appeal should necessarily contain the following; (a) Review Medical Examination fee of Rs.25/-(Rupees twenty five) only **non refundable**, through a **Bank Draft/ IPO** in favour of “**PAO, SSB (MHA), New Delhi**”, (b) Appeal Form 4, 5 & 6 issued by the Initial Medical Board declaring the candidate as Unfit, (c) One self addressed envelope with Rs.6/- postage stamp duly affixed on it. **Fitness certificate other than on Form – 6 (provided by the Chairman of Recruitment Board to the Candidates) submitted to appeal for Review Medical Examination will not be considered and rejected straightway.**

The fitness certificate on Form- 6 is essential to consider their cases for review medical examination and not for any other purpose.

Path/ Lab test expenses if any, occurred during Review Medical Examination will be born by the candidates.

Those candidates whose appeal found in order will be issued call letters to appear for Review Medical Examination and their list will also be uploaded in the SSB Website www.ssbrectt.gov.in . They may keep in touch to know their date of appearing in review medical examination and venue by visiting our website.

The decision of the Review Medical Board of SSB will be final and no 2nd appeal will be entertained as per Govt. instructions and also no reply of the correspondence / 2nd appeal will be given / entertained.

11. All eligible candidates will be duly informed about the date and venue of the recruitment tests through Admit Cards. Candidates should come duly prepared for 6-7 days stay under their own arrangements at the Recruitment Centre. SSB will not be responsible for damage / injury, if any, to the individual sustained during the

Physical Efficiency Test. Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected and no correspondence on this will be made/ entertained. No application will be accepted after the last date as mentioned at para – 7.

Note :- SSB will not be responsible for postal delays and loss of applications, if any. The Director General, SSB reserves the right to make changes or cancel or postpone the recruitment without assigning any reason.

12. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Candidates should read the instructions very carefully before filling up the application form.
2. No change/alteration will be permitted once the form has been submitted.
3. Incomplete or incorrectly filled forms will be rejected.
4. Candidates are advised to keep a photocopy of the form with them after filling it.
5. Signature of the candidate throughout the recruitment process should be the same as put in the application form.
6. Candidates failing in any of the prescribed tests will be eliminated at that stage.
7. Candidature will be summarily rejected at any stage of the recruitment process for not confirming to the official Format/having incomplete information/wrong information/incomplete requisite certificates/misrepresentation of facts.
8. Any sort of canvassing or recommendation will debar the candidate from selection.
9. Candidates should come duly prepared to stay for 5-6 days at their own arrangements at the place Recruitment. TA for onward and return journey to SC/ST candidates will be paid as per G.O.I. instructions to those who appear in written test subject to production of rail / bus tickets, original caste certificate, non-employment certificate from M.P. / MLA or any other gazetted officer of the locality in case they are not employed in Central / State Govt. Mobile Phone and Calculator are strictly prohibited in the recruitment venue.
10. Mere qualifying all the prescribed tests in SSB recruitment of Constable (Tradesmen) does not confer the right of selection of the candidates but they

should have to stand in merit keeping in view the available vacancies. The vacancies are subject to change.

11. Success in various stages of recruitment confers no right to appointment unless the department is satisfied after medical examination and such enquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respect for appointment to the service/post.
12. Candidates have to appear in all the stages of Recruitment for which they have to qualify. If a candidate is absented from any stage/event for which he has to qualify, his candidature will be cancelled.
13. On appointment, the candidate shall be governed by SSB Act and Rules as amended from time to time. They shall be entitled for the pension benefits as per the "New Restructured Defined Contributory Pension Scheme" applicable for the new entrants to the Central Government Services w.e.f. 01-01-2004.
14. Selected candidates are liable to serve anywhere with in as well as outside the territory of India.
15. Selected candidates are required to undergo BRTC in SSB RTCs for which they will be informed separately through offer of appointment letter. They will be on probation for a period of two years which can be extended. During the period of probation if found unfit for any reason the services are liable to be terminated.
16. In case a candidate is found in-eligible for service/post on any ground after his selection/appointment his services will be terminated without assigning any reason.
